Dear CPCC Instructors:

On Wednesday, October 11th, all Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools eleventh graders are required to take the PSAT Test. This will require all Merancas Middle College High School eleventh graders to miss their CPCC classes during the testing time. PSAT Test administration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and finish at approximately 12:00 p.m. I respectfully request that all Merancas Middle College High School students impacted by this requirement be excused from attending your class on Wednesday, October 11th between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. They will be responsible for any make-up work.

We are also required to do a **Pre-Registration meeting for the PSAT**. Our eleventh graders will be meeting on Tuesday, **October 10**th **from 11:20-12:00** to complete the pre-registration tasks. This should not impact your class time.
